2nd COURSE FOR FAMILY MOVEMENTS – "Geppetto II"

Loreto, 6-12 July 2025

PRESENTATION

This formation is jointly proposed by the *Pontifical Theological Institute John Paul II for the Sciences of Marriage and Family* and the *Dicastery for Laity, Family and Life* in partnership with the *Pontifical Sanctuary of the Holy House of Loreto* on the impulse of the *Geppetto International Pilot Training* 2022-2023. It is especially designed **for couples strongly committed in their Family Movement, on which the Movement counts for the future**.

Following the evaluation done in September 2023 with the participating movements (*Equipes Notre-Dame, Love and Truth, Marriage Encounter*), it capitalizes on the strengths of the pilot training: the opportunity to deepen the charism of one's movement in encountering other movements, the service of mission in the Catholic Church, a high level theological and pastoral formation, in the spiritual tradition of Loreto. At the same time, some changes have been made: only one week in presence (instead of two long week-ends) in order to reduce travel costs, translation in four languages to avoid English as a common language (Italian, English, Spanish, French), presence of women and different profiles in the teaching staff.

As agreed with the Movements in September 2023 **three major steps** have been designed, emphasizing an ecclesiological orientation (spiritual, fundamental, practical):

- spiritual: The Sacrament of Marriage in the light of the Loreto message;
- fundamental: Movements take part in the mission of the Church with their own charism;
- *practical*: How can each movement prepare their members to collaborate for mission within the local Churches (parishes, other movements).

The synodal dynamics of mission in relation to *Amoris Laetitia*, already used in the 2023 Geppetto formation, has become even more relevant this year with the final document of the October 2024 Synod of Bishops: "For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, Mission".

In that respect, the formation is opened to other family movements with a world impact, submitted to the discernment of the Dicastery for Laity, Family and Life.

PRACTICAL ASPECTS:

- We shall meet on **Sunday**, **June 6th at 1:30 PM** in front of the **Baptistery of San Giovanni in Laterano** to depart by bus for **Loreto**.
- For Tuesday's dinner, each couple is kindly invited to bring some food from their home country to share with the group.
- Simultaneous translation will be available every morning for plenary meeting. Each person will need to bring a Wi-Fi enabled device (such as a tablet, mobile phone, or PC) and headphones in order to access the live simultaneous translation via Zoom. In the afternoon, we'll be divided in linguistic groups: English, French, Spanish.
- There will be a variety of methodologies for both plenary presentations and linguistic groups. However, the "conversation in the Spirit" method will be preferred.
